Fees and Refund Policy

Fees

Fees are payable in full when you enrol. Places on any courses are only secure upon receipt of the full payment.

Funded courses - Learners must be 19 years or above, have lived in an EEA (European Economic Area) country for the last 3 or more years.

Full cost: Learners who have NOT lived in an EEA country for the last 3 or more years have to pay the full cost of the fees.

Refunds

Please note that if you choose to withdraw from the course you will not be entitled to a refund.

Refunds will be paid in full when a class is closed at the discretion of CELS, or if you cancel your enrolment at least two weeks before the course starts.

You will receive a 50% refund if you decide to cancel less than two weeks before the course starts.

If the course is cancelled, we will contact you to offer an alternative or a refund.

Concessionary Fees – This applies to people who are in receipt of “Guaranteed Credit” in relation to the Pension Credit, or who are in receipt of a means tested benefit or who are unemployed. To be eligible, applicants must supply their National Insurance Number and photocopied proof of a document relevant to the benefit and academic year.

CELS does not offer “Payment by Instalments” facility for its courses.
